The Kartell catalogue adds yet another piece to its furniture collection, the commode. Starck has taken a new look at it and the Kartell-style commode evokes the lines of classic furniture while its transparency and plastic material give it a contemporary voice. Corners and curves, straight lines and sinuous play over its surfaces and give life to an intriguing game of eye-catching perspectives and reflections. Ghost Buster with three open front shelves and four bifacial legs is the largest plastic monobloc ever yet made in the world of furnishings - another demonstration of Kartell's determination to break down all the barriers of technical challenge.


